

SNAKE RIVER BIRDS OF PREY NATURAL AREA: On I-84, take exit 44 South on Highway 69. Travel south from Kuna across Indian Creek to Kuna Way. Turn south on Swan Falls Rd. that leads to the Snake River Birds of Prey Natural Area established in 1971 on 26,000 acres.



SILVER CITY: Take 1-84 W to Exit 27 towards Wilder then turn Left on 1-84 Bus Loop E/Centennial Way. Turn Right onto E. Simplot Blvd/ID-19 follow for 11 miles. Turn Left onto highway 95/US-95 S. continuing into Oregon (33 miles). Turn Left onto Silver City Rd., right onto Old Highway 95 S and the take the first left onto Cow Creek Rd. Silver City is the queen of Idaho ghost towns; must views are the Old Schoolhouse Museum, Hotel and Graveyard...





LESLIE GULCH: Take I-84 east to Exit 33, turn right onto HWY 55/Karcher Rd, and follow it for about 17 miles, then take Hwy 95 South, follow it south for about 26 miles and turn right onto McBride Creek Rd, you'll see the sign for Leslie Gulch. Follow the signs to Leslie Gulch on the remaining 22 miles of dirt road to this surprisingly beautiful canyon of red rock spires and desert scape; keep your eyes open for big horn sheep.

RESORT GUIDELINES


- Please relax and enjoy yourself. Your comfort is our top priority; please let us know if we can be of any assistance.
