SNAKE RIVER BIRDS OF PREY NATURAL AREA: On I-84, take exit 44 south on Highway 69. Travel south from Kuna across Indian Creek to Kuna Way. Turn south on Swan Falls Rd. that leads to the Snake River Birds of Prey Natural Area established in 1971 on 26,000 acres





BRUNEAU DUNES: Take Highway 51 south from Mountain Home. Once you cross the Snake River Bridge, before arriving in Bruneau, you will see signs for the Dunes on the left on the highway. Turn left onto Highway 78. The Dunes are about a mile down on the right. This is a State Park with admission fee.

SILVER CITY: Take I-84 east toward Nampa/Boise, and exit 35, north side Blvd. Turn right onto North side/Nampa Blvd, and follow this as it turns into N Yale St. Turn right onto 12th Ave S (ID-45), follow this south for 17.8 miles, and then it becomes ID-78. Continue on ID-78 past Murphy 4.1 miles, then turn southwest onto Silver City Road, which is gravel roadfor the first 5.4 miles and then dirt road for the remaining 13 miles. Silver City is the queen of Idaho ghost towns; must-sees include the Old Schoolhouse Museum, Hotel and Graveyard.





LESLIE GULCH: Take I-84 east to Exit 33, turn right onto HWY 55/Karcher Rd, and followit for about 17 miles, then take Hwy 95 South, follow it south for about 26 miles and turn right onto McBride Creek Rd, you'll see the sign for Leslie Gulch. Follow the signs to LeslieGulch on the remaining 22 miles of dirt road to this surprisingly beautiful canyon of red rock spires and desert scape; keep your eyes open for big horn sheep.


RESORT GUIDELINES
